DECENTRALIZE/STRENGTHEN EPIDEMIOLOGICAL EXPERTISE

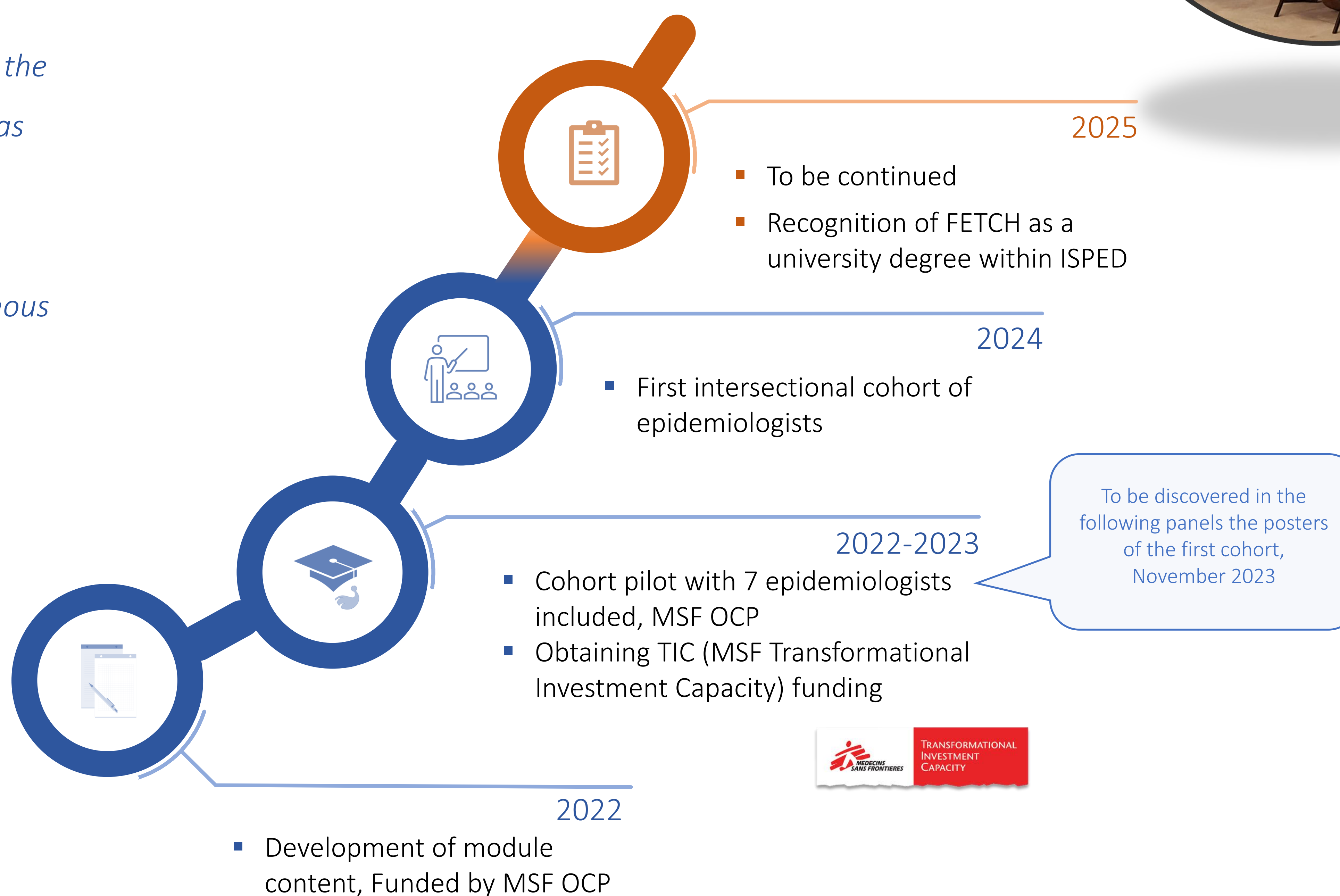


- To strengthen the missions' ability to **make decisions based on sound, high-quality scientific data**

- Support operational strategy and **promote high quality of care** by improving the timeliness, relevance and quality of epidemiological activities
- Train and tutor **field epidemiologists**
- Collaborate with and accompany coordination
